■ Abstract Submission

Abstract Format

- Include author(s)' personal information such as Full Name, Position, Department, Affiliation, City & Country, E-mail, Phone Number in the abstract form.
- Every abstract should be written in the abstract form within 250 words; research abstracts should include Background, Objectives, Methods, Results and Conclusions, while case reports do not necessarily need to describe these factors and can be freely formatted.
- Abstracts must be text only and submitted in English; abstracts should not contain any illustrations, images, graphs or tables.

Abstract Acceptance Notification

- Notification of abstract acceptance will be provided by email at the end of March.
- All submitted abstracts will be assessed by the scientific program committee and accepted abstracts will be included in our abstract book that will be published and distributed to participants, while being displayed as Poster at the KHRS 2018.
- Presenting authors of accepted abstracts will be exempt from the payment of registration fee.
- Top 5 best authors among all authors of accepted abstracts will be provided with \$500 travel grant.

Abstract Modification/Withdrawal

- Authors may further edit submitted abstracts and send us again within the submission deadline, but once acceptance notification is made, no alterations will be permitted to the abstract content.
- After the deadline, the scientific committee may rectify errors (e.g. typos, misspellings, grammatical errors, etc.) to publish the abstract book.
