The ESC offers Research Fellowships and Training Fellowships in open competition to help young cardiologists and science graduates acquire research and training experience in European centres of excellence.

To be eligible for either a Research Fellowship or a Training Fellowship you have to be aged < 36 years old, a medical or science (PhD or equivalent) graduate, and in permanent residence in an ESC or ESC Affiliated member country.

Eight grants of Euros 25,000 each are available in the current round.

ESC RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS

For medical or science graduates

The purpose is to provide an opportunity to undertake specialised research in the cardiovascular field in an ESC member country, other than their own, for medical graduates at any stage in their career but before obtaining a permanent post, or for science graduates with research experience up to Assistant Professorship level. The goal is to help young candidates to gain research experience in an academic centre of excellence.

ESC TRAINING FELLOWSHIPS

For medical graduates

The purpose is to provide an opportunity for clinical training in cardiology in an ESC member country, other than their own, for medical graduates having completed the major part of their cardiology training but before obtaining a permanent post. The goal is to help young candidates attain clinical competence and acquire experience of high quality cardiological practice which will enable them to contribute to improving clinical standards on return to their own country.
