IN 2009 THE BRIC COUNTRIES MET FOR THE FIRST OFFICIAL SUMMIT IN EKATERINBURG, AND THE CITY IS ONE OF COMPETITORS TO HOST WORLD EXPO IN 2020.

In 2015 the main title of Russian Cardiovascular Days is interactive discussion of clinical cases in light of late European guidelines. Lectures are to be presented by leading Russian and foreign specialists. Within the Forum poster session will be held.

Lectures and clinical cases are dedicated to the new treatment methods of heart failure, chronic IHD, pulmonary embolism and atrial fibrillation.

Each participant of the forum registered in the program will receive CME credits for active participation in the Russian Cardiovascular Days. Later these CME credits will be recorded as study hours during next advanced training.
