



Case competition for young electrophysiologists, fellows, and trainees in AF ablation

Dear “young” colleagues,

Biosense Webster is happy to open a ***Call for Case Reports*** to be presented during the 10th Practical Session in Atrial Fibrillation, on February 7th, 2018 to be held in Prague.

Young electrophysiologists, fellows, and trainees are invited to submit a brief, highly informative, single-case report that exemplifies any of the following 5 main topics:

“Challenges with...”	
1. Anatomy	... with transseptal puncture
2. Workflow & fluoroscopy	... Reduction of radiation exposure
3. All about Effective Ablation Lesions	... with Effective Ablation Lesions
4. Real Life Decisions	... Post Ablation Atrial Flutter
5. Facing Complications: How to...	... intraprocedural complications / periprocedural thromboembolism / atrio-esophageal fistula / pulmonary vein complications

Submissions should adhere to the following instructions:

1. A maximum of 6 authors is allowed.
2. The 1st author should be a young electrophysiologist (i.e. <40 years, ≤5 years out of training), fellow, or trainee in AF ablation. The status of “*young electrophysiologist, fellows, or trainee*” should be accredited by a letter from the Arrhythmia Unit Director/Supervisor.
3. The case-report manuscript should include a single image or table, a short title, a case description anywhere from 250 to 500 words including a 60-word abstract, and up to 3 references.
4. The figure should be in one of the following formats: tiff, bitmap (.bmp), jpeg (.jpg), postscript (.ps or .eps). Minimum image resolution required is 300 ppp.
5. All authors should declare any conflict of interests in a separate document.
